Health Insurance Marketplace: The Marketplace is a new way to find quality health coverage. It can help if you don't have coverage now or if you have it but want to look at other options. With one Marketplace application, you can learn if you can get lower costs based on your income, compare your coverage options side-by-side, and enroll.

HealthCare.gov and **Cuidadodesalud.gov:** Official website for consumers for information on signing up for health coverage through the Marketplace.

Marketplace.CMS.gov: Website for partners/stakeholders for the latest resources to help people apply, enroll, and get coverage in 2014. Here you will find info on how to **partner** with CMS, get **training**, and **official resources**.

Certified Application Counselors (CACs): If your organization is a community health center or other health care provider, hospital, a non-federal governmental or non-profit social service agency in a state with a Federally-facilitated Marketplace or a State Partnership Marketplace, and your organization would like to help by training your staff to assist people applying for coverage through the Marketplace, you can apply to be a Certified application counselor (CAC) organization.

- CACs perform many of the same functions as Navigators and non-Navigator assistance personnel—including educating consumers and helping them complete an application for coverage
